

**FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHILDREN'S CENTER
COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY WAIVER FOR PARENTS**

- I understand that I must keep my child home for any of the following reasons: extreme fatigue, a temperature over 100.0 within the last 24 hours, medicated for fever with fever-reducing medication within 24 hours, rash or hives, bad cough or thick nasal discharge, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, gastrointestinal issues including vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours, loss of taste or smell, or any other documented symptoms of COVID-19.
- I understand that I must complete a daily health screening for each of my children every day before dropping them off.
- I understand that if my child registers a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher he/she will not be allowed to enter the building.
- I understand drop off/pick up will take place outside the building, and that parents and visitors are not allowed in the building at this time.
- I understand hand-sanitizer will be used when soap and water are not available.
- I understand that if my child feels ill or registers a temperature of 100.0 or above while at school I must arrange for pick-up as soon as possible while my child waits with a staff member in a designated area outside of the classroom. I will notify the office when I have arrived and my child will be escorted to the Jefferson Avenue entrance for pick up.
- I understand that if I think or know that my child has COVID-19 and **has symptoms** I will keep him/her home until he/she meets the following requirements to return to school: 10 days since the symptoms first appeared, 3 days with no fever, AND respiratory symptoms have improved.
- I understand that if my child tests positive for COVID-19 and **has no symptoms** I will keep him/her home until 10 days have passed since the test.
- I understand that anyone who has been in close contact with someone with COVID-19 must not attend school and must not drop off or pick up a student for 14 days after exposure.
- I understand that if my family is planning to travel I will inform the school office prior to such travel.
- I understand that depending on the circumstances at FPCC and throughout the community, a decision may be made in conjunction with St. Louis County Health officials to close the school or reduce the capacity of the school for a temporary or long-term period.
- I expressly acknowledge that even with the efforts to regularly disinfect and sanitize surfaces and with social distancing and extra safety practices in place, my child's attendance could result in an exposure to COVID-19. I release and hold harmless First Presbyterian Children's Center, First Presbyterian Church, and their staff with respect to any and all illnesses to the fullest extent permitted by law.
